& fun environment. Classes are filling up, but enrollment is still open!! Call for more information—485-2192.





We really thought that it would be a slow summer this year because of Covid-19. Wow, were we wrong! God has given us wonderful things to do. We were so fortunate to be able to have two camps —back-to-back in the same location but with different campers.

We taught English, led Bible discussions, gave our testimonies, and built relationships. Jhane, who had come to the Truth Project at our house before the shutdown, made the decision to trust Christ personally and was baptized at camp along with a young man we have known for many years. Despite being terrified of water and living with a disability that requires a wheelchair, he also decided that he wanted to be baptized. It was a joyous day! Zuza, a young woman who had come to camp for three years in a row, decided to trust Jesus as her Saviour

and Lord. Two more teenagers also made decisions for Christ at camp. On March 8th, 2020, we had the last gathering of the Truth Project at our place before the coronavirus disrupted all of our lives. Within days, our lives changed. Within two weeks, Jhane was in the hospital with the virus and soon Esther also became sick. Thankfully, both recovered!
