Annual Meeting

Sunday, December 13th 10:15 am Items for discussion will be the 2021 Budget and the information on an Elder Board.

- November is a month of gratitude. A month of giving thanks. And it is inspired by a young woman named Edon Ladig, and a dare from Ann Voskamp's book, One Thousand Gifts, that Edon chose to live out.
- Edon was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia on March 9, 2019, and on January 9, 2020, she went home to be with Jesus. Edon was 33 years old and left behind her husband, 6 children, and a beautiful legacy of her faith
- in God. Edon and her husband prayed early on in her diagnosis that no matter what the outcome, that God would use their journey to glorify Him. And though it wasn't always easy, because of their faith and trust in God, they
 walked through those 10 months with peace and happiness. During her 10 month journey, Edon set out to finish
- Ann Voskamp's challenge of counting our blessings, and writing down 1000 things you are grateful for. Edon made it to 724 blessings before she passed away.
- The book One Thousand Gifts, asks how do I fully live when life is full of hurt? How do we find joy in the midst of deadlines, debt, drama, and daily duties? In the book, Ann invites you to wake up to God's everyday blessings, to dare to live life fully right where you are. In an excerpt from Ann's book, she says...
- "There is hope and transformative power in counting our blessings and naming the good gifts of God because
 we encounter the power of God Himself in our lives. If you want to discover the rhythms of grace, joy, and true thankfulness, count the gifts God has given and the ones He is giving you even at this moment.
- G Write them down, express them in words, notice them, and celebrate each one. Start with ten, then take off your shoes and count ten more gifts. Now you have twenty. Keep going: a hundred gifts, two hundred, and you will discover there are super more. When you get to a they and gifts use will be getting use more due "
- s discover there are even more. When you get to a thousand gifts, you will be getting warmed up."
