

A Tax Review for Seniors 72 or Older Regarding Your RMDs

You may be missing an available tax opportunity regarding your donations to Faith Baptist Church. This tax benefit applies to those of you who are required to take each year Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) from your taxdeferred retirement account.

Providing certain rules are met, you can exclude your donations from your federal and state taxable income. This may also help to reduce the taxable portion of your Social Security payments received.

To receive this benefit requires your donations to be made directly from your IRA. These distribution donations will then be counted toward satisfying your RMD for the year. One method to accomplish this benefit is to have your IRA custodian set up a checking account for you in your IRA account.
