Dear Friends and Family,

PRAY FOR HAITI! Early Saturday morning, August 14, southwestern **Haiti was hit with a 7.2 magnitude earthquake.** All MAF staff are safe and we have initiated relief efforts with numerous other groups, such as Samaritan's Purse, Missionary Flights International, and Agape Flights.

A little over a week later, the death toll is now over 2,200, with more than 12,000 injured, and hundreds still missing! Nearly 53,000 homes are understood to be destroyed, as well as many churches, hospitals, and

schools. Three days after the quake, tropical storm Grace dumped some 10 inches of rain on that part of Haiti, triggering mudslides, hampering relief efforts—already slowed by damaged bridges and roads, as well as gang violence that has been rising in recent years!

MAF flights are crucial—carrying medical response teams and extra staff, medicines, and other supplies to the affected areas. Return flights carry injured patients that need special care.

One example is with a partner called Danita's Children. On August 20, we transported three physicians and five nurses, as well as 800 pounds of medical supplies, to Jeremie.

The MAF documentary, Ends of the Earth, will make its theater debut on October 18 and 21. It will show in over 700 movie theaters nationwide as a Fathom event, with releases for viewing in churches intended as well.

Ends of the Earth will tell the story of MAF's work with our partners to fulfill the Great Commission. Our desire in sharing this story is to inspire others to respond to the call to serve in missions with MAF or others and help bring the transformative power of the gospel to isolated people.

It was nice to have Abby and her boyfriend Adam along with us for the first part of our trip. One highlight for us was to spend time with family and friends. Our time


